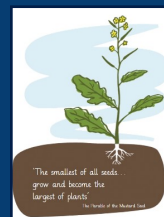

Year 1

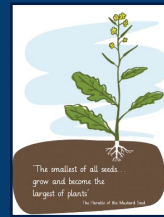


Fawns Class enjoyed visiting the Coram Life Education tent with Harold the Giraffe last week, learning all about their bodies and keeping healthy.

Year 3 and Year 5



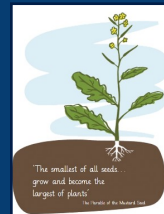
Giants Class and the Griffins worked together this afternoon to learn key cricket skills including batting and under-arm bowling.

Congratulations to the children who topped our leaderboards in our 'How Have You Grown?' worship at the end of last term.

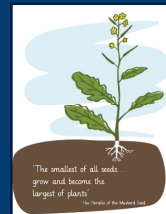
Keep up the hard work!
