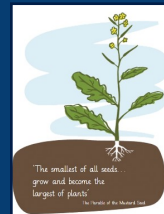

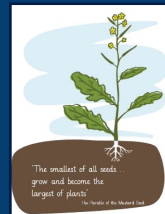


Fawns Class have enjoyed a fabulous afternoon of learning—after outdoor PE, they explored seeds and fruits in science!

Griffins designed and created Mayan masks as part of their history learning.



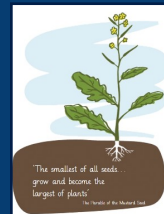

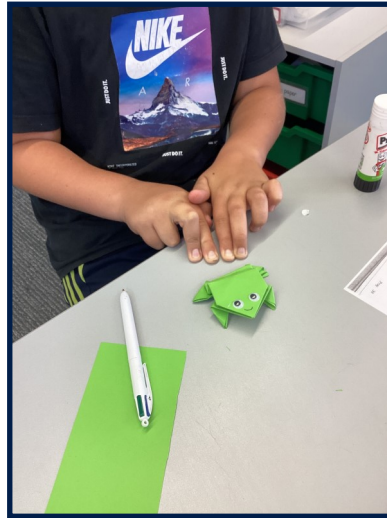
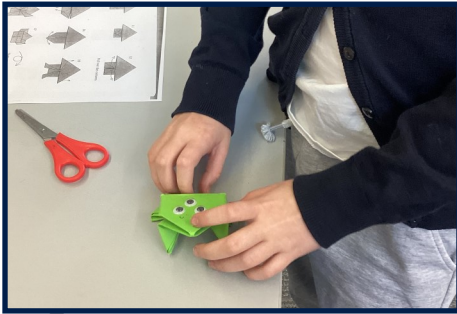


Giants Class explored shadows as part of their science learning this term.

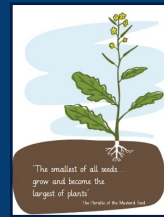
