Y1/Y2 Phonics Screening Check and Y4 Multiplication Check

Next week, all children in YI will be completing their phonics screening check, in addition to those children in Y2 who didn't reach the pass mark last year. The test itself is quick and easy (children may not even realise they are doing it!) and simply requires children to read some real words and some 'alien' words made up of sounds they have been taught.
