We have one more tour organised for Monday at 4:30pm. If you know of any families with children starting school in September 2025, please do share this with them.



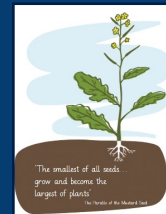
Behaviour Policy

Our school, along with all other schools across DGAT, have adopted the trust's Behaviour Policy, whilst incorporating our own effective approach within it.

As a result of the work we undertook on behaviour and continue to sustain, we are proud to report that:

- Our behaviour policy is underpinned by our vision 'The smallest of seeds... grow and become the largest of plants' and we teach children to live out our Christian Values of respect, compassion, forgiveness, hope, responsibility and courage with themselves and each other
- The school has embedded a trauma-informed approach. We use emotion coaching and restorative practice to help children regulate their emotions and move forward from conflict; this is used consistently by all
- Parents and visitors consistently and frequently comment on the excellent behaviour demonstrated by our children in class, at school, out in the community and on school trips
- We consistently report a significantly low number of behaviour incidents to the Local Governing Body each term
