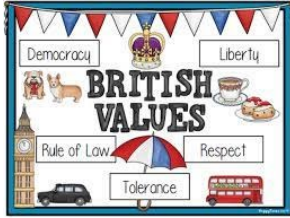


Dear Families,

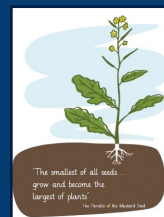
