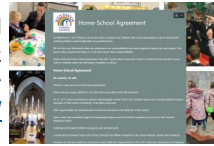
Welcome back to a new term!

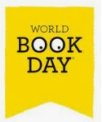

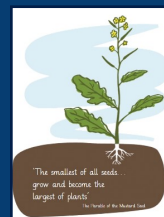
